Interviews: Talk to each other and, more importantly, remember to listen...

- 1) When and where were you baptized?
- 2) Tell about your childhood church experience. Did you have one? Where? What was it like? Any good memories? Any bad ones? Any people you can remember that made an impact in you?
 - <u>Sponsors only</u>: Were you confirmed? Where and when? Was it a positive or negative experience over all? What did the experience mean to you?
- 3) Talk about your childhood. Describe your family of origin. What was school like? How did you spend your time? Activities? Struggles? Successes?
- 4) Talk about the present day. Describe your family. How do you spend most of your time these days? What are your interests? Describe one of your good friends and tell why he/she is a good friend to have.
- 5) Share one of your strengths and one weakness.
- 6) What is one of your biggest fears?
- 7) Share one hope for the future (personal or worldwide or anything in between).
- 8) What's one thing about Christianity that you have trouble believing in or that you disagree with?
- 9) What's one thing about Christianity that you believe in very strongly or that you believe is very important?
- 10) What's one thing you like about our church? What's one thing you wish were different about it?
- 11) When have you felt closest to God?
- 12) What are some ways that you will connect with one another this year? (think service projects, conversation opportunities, worship)
